EVENTS:

- 9:00 am Special Olympic Events: 1 KM TT
- 10:00 Juniors 10-12 Boys and 10-12 Girls : 10 Km separate start
- 10:30 am Special Olympic 10 km RR
- 11:00 am Special Olympic 2 KM TT
- 11:45 pm Juniors 13-14 Boys and Girls* - separate starts : 15 km
- 12:30 pm Special Olympic 5 KM RR
- 1:00 pm Special Olympic 500 meter TT
- 1:30 pm Junior Boys and Girls 15-18: separate starts 25km
Younger juniors may race an older age group

*If there are less than four 13-14 junior boys and girls - the race will be moved to the 1:30 time slot

INFORMATION:

Times are approximate, event will start as soon as the preceding event finishes but no earlier than the stated time.

Promoter may combine age groups if less than 4 riders are registered.

Places: 3 places per class. Prizes include trophies and merchandise— approximate prize value per class is \$60.

Course description: (Same as 2008) 1 km loop with 2 turns, one small hill

Registration opens at 8:00 am and closes 30 minutes before each event.

Entry Fee: \$10 per race ;second race \$5; BAR points scored for 10-14 in13-14class

Licenses: (All racers must have USCF licenses - full year or one day) One day

USCF licenses will be available to purchase onsite. Need service hours? Come early!

DIRECTIONS:

PCTC Driver Training Facility, Sykesville, MD. FROM BALTIMORE: Take I70 to MD32

(Sykesville Rd) exit #80, North 4 miles to Raincliff Rd. (2nd light after exiting I70)

Turn right onto Raincliff Rd: proceed 1 mile turn left onto Slacks Rd. Urban Grid course

just past the building for Driver Training School. FROM WASHINGTON DC: Take I95

or BW Parkway NORTH to MD 32 North, go past I-70 and follow directions above.
