Start times are approximate; event will start as soon as the preceding event finished but no earlier than the stated time. Promoter may combine age groups if less than 4 riders are registered. BAR points scored for 10-14 in 13-14 class. Three places will be awarded per class. Prizes include trophies and merchandise— approximate prize value per class is \$60. Course is the same as in 2009, a 1 km loop with 2 turns, one small hill.

From Baltimore: Take I-70 to MD-32 (Sykesville Rd) exit #80; Go north 4 miles to Rainscliff Rd. (2nd light after exiting I-70); Turn right onto Raincliff Rd; Proceed 1 mile turn left onto Slacks Rd. *Urban Grid* course is just past the building for the *Driver Training School*.

From Washington DC: Take I-95 or BW Parkway north to MD-32 north; go past I-70 and follow directions above.
