GENERAL INFORMATION

Race Entries: You will be entered in all races for your age class races, except World Cup Hill Climb. Only one pairs Time Trial, extra pairs Time Trial \$15

Documents: All participants must have a valid passport. All racers must have a valid USAC international license IF you intend to enter the UCI sanctioned races. However, there are races available for nonlicensed riders. Please specify if you wish to enter only non licensed races.

Equipment: the following equipment is recommended: spare set of wheels, spare tires, any essential tools, pump, rags, bike cleaning fluid, wheel bags, old skewer for riding a trainer, hill climbing cassette with 26, 24, 22, 20, 18, 16 TEST HILL CLIMB Cassettes BEFORE DEPARTURE! Do not forget cassette puller/cog tools, 290-350 gram rims and 250 gram tires are sufficient. Spare rear derailleur, cables and chain might be useful. **Road and TT bikes for UCI World Championships must be UCI legal.** **Clothing:** Good weather will be dry, 70 to 80 degrees, bad weather can be rain in the 50's. Chances of some rain, especially at the World Championships are good. BRING AN UMBRELLA. Bring riding tights and a rain parka. A turtleneck shirt and sweater will be useful some evenings. **Miscellaneous articles:** Consider following: bar of soap, laundry soap, clothes line, wash cloth, AC/DC converter, a large coffee cup, corkscrew, knife, small backpack, string bag for shopping. German-English dictionary, alarm clock, books, **Cash:** \$300.00 cash is plenty. More would be required for purchase of bicycle parts, clothing, gifts and so forth. Remember, BEVERAGES ARE NOT INCLUDED! ATM machines are available. The hotels do not take credit cards to pay your bar bill.

UCI MASTERS WORLD ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP: ST. JOHANN IN TIROL

The Championship course is a 40km circuit with 2 moderate climbs, max. 7% grade. The course climbs from the town of St. Johann to a higher mountain valley, descends into a lower valley and returns around the other side of a mountain. Race distances vary from 1 to 3 laps depending on age and sex. Riders may train on the course at any time even though there are 3 to 4 races on the course each day. Award ceremonies are held every night after the races. The Hill Climb is held Monday morning. All other races begin at 1:00 to 1:40 p.m. Depending on what day race, there will be time to visit Salzburg, Innsbruck, Kitzbuhl or just to experiment with other training rides off the course. The Grossglockner pass is an hour's drive for those who want 30km of 42 x 30.
